The Mahatma Gandhi Institute is inviting applications from interested and suitably qualified candidates to enroll on a 10 weeks short course leading to a **Certificate of Completion**. The course will be conducted by the Mahatma Gandhi Institute at the seat of the **Institute, Moka**.

This course is ideal for all married and engaged couples who are seeking to strengthen their relationship. Some couples are willing to invest in their relationship and others are looking to address more specific challenges. The course will be conducted by academics and experts in the specified field including lecturers and religious leaders to enable youngsters as well as married couples better understand the different meanings on this essential event in their lives. The main aim of this course is to help students have more fulfilling familial relationships during their lives.

Upon successfully completing this course, participants should be able to:

- Understand the historical, contemporary, cultural, and sacredness of marriage and family issues;
- Appreciate cultural diversity of families;
- Recognize common patterns of family interaction, identify and evaluate gender role expectations and their implications for relationships; and
- Develop interpersonal skills which strengthen marital and family relationships.

- (i) A pass in English Language at Cambridge School Certificate/ 'O' Level or equivalent and credit in four (4) subjects at Cambridge School Certificate/ GCE 'O' Level.
- (ii) Two 'A' levels at Higher School Certificate

(b) An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

Applications should be made on the prescribed forms obtainable during office hours, from the Reception Counters, SMAS Building, Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka and the Rabindranath Tagore Institute, Ilot. The application forms, duly filled in, must be returned **together with photocopies of birth certificate, marriage certificate and certificate of naturalization (where applicable) and educational certificates** so as to reach the Director- General's Office, Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka 80808, not later than **Friday 10 January 2025**.

Applications received after the closing date and/or not supported by the **relevant documents** will not be considered.

Fees payable

Registration Fees : **Rs 125/- (non-refundable)**

Course Fees : **Rs 1500/- (non-refundable fee payable at the time of registration)**

The course should be clearly marked on the top left-hand corner of the envelope.

Only successful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications. A limited number of 30 seats is available and is based on a first come first serve basis.

Courses will be run once weekly for 3 hours.

The course will start tentatively at the beginning of January 2025. The course duration is 10 weeks on a part time basis.
