ENLISTMENT OF SUPPLY TEACHER (SECONDARY)

Applications are invited from **suitably qualified candidates outside the service** who wish to be considered for enlistment as Supply Teacher (Secondary) for the teaching of the subjects listed below in the MGI & RTI Secondary Schools. Supply Teachers will be enlisted on a purely temporary basis, as and when the need arises, during the academic year **2026**.

1. Biology
2. Chemistry
3. Economics
4. Modern Chinese (Mandarin)
5. Music:
 - (i) Indian Music (Vocal) – Carnatic
 - (ii) Music (Instrumental) – Mridangam
6. Performing Arts:

Classical Dance – Kuchipudi
7. Telugu

QUALIFICATIONS

A. Candidates should possess:

- (i)
 - (a) a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings or
 - (b) passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (a) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (b) in six subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;
- (ii) a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”;
- (iii)
 - (a) a degree or joint degree in relation to the subject to be taught from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the MGI & RTI Council;

or

- (b) a Bachelor of Education related to the subject to be taught from a recognised institution.

B. For the subjects at Nos. 5 and 6 above, listed in the Fourth Schedule Education (Amendment) Regulations 2025 of the Education Act

In absence of qualified candidates possessing the qualification at A (iii), consideration will be given to candidates possessing a Diploma, pitched at Level 6 on the National Qualifications Framework.

They will be paid a monthly allowance of Rs29,477/- plus salary compensation at the approved rates (PRB 2026). The candidates will be paid on a pro-rata basis, based on the number of days of attendance.

NOTE 1

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal level” and one subject at “Subsidiary level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examination.

NOTE 2

Candidates possessing qualifications laid down at A (i) – (iii) will draw a monthly allowance of Rs35,353/- plus salary compensation at the approved rates (PRB 2026). The candidates will be paid on a pro-rata basis, based on the number of days of attendance.

REFUND OF TRAVELLING EXPENSES

Bus fares will be refunded on the basis of the number of days of attendance at the approved rates.

AGE LIMIT

Candidates should not have reached their 70th birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications. However, priority of consideration will be given to young graduates with the required qualifications. In scarcity areas, the services of candidates up to 70 years will be enlisted.

MODE OF APPLICATION

Application forms for the post are available at the Reception Counters of the Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka and Rabindranath Tagore Institute, Ilot, Pamplemousses. The form can also be downloaded from the website of the MGI at the following address:

Applications should be made on the **prescribed form** and returned, duly filled in, along with copies of the Birth, Marriage (where applicable), Academic and Professional Certificates, **transcripts of the modules covered** in the Diploma/Degree, evidence of teaching experience, if any and a valid Certificate of Character.

IMPORTANT

- (i) Candidates should clearly indicate on their Application Forms the subject for which they are applying and should be clearly marked on the top left-hand corner of the envelope. Failure to do so may entail their elimination from the competition.
- (ii) Candidates willing to be considered for more than one subject should fill in separate Application Forms subject wise and should also indicate the subject for which they are applying.
- (iii) Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the applicant. Only the prescribed Application Form should be used.
- (iv) Candidates will be contacted, as far as possible, by email and phone. Candidates are therefore advised to submit valid email address as well as a phone number on which they can be easily contacted.
- (v) The MGI reserves the right to convene only the best qualified candidates for interview.

Please note that applicants who do not possess a Certificate of Character will be required to produce the receipt for their application for same as evidence.

The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the competent authorities rests solely upon the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.
