## *Short Course in Sanskrit* *SANSKRIT SOPANA (Part-Time)* *(INTAKE 2026)*

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for enrolment on the Sanskrit Sopana Course offered by the School of Indological Studies, Department of Sanskrit, at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute for the Academic Year 2026.

### **Sanskrit Sopana**

This course aims at providing learners with foundational knowledge and basic skills in Sanskrit through transliteration (लिप्यन्तर) and translation (भाषान्तर). It develops learners' listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in Sanskrit with a reasonable level of competency and comprehension.

The programme is designed for secondary school students as well as beginners wishing to study Sanskrit in a systematic and progressive manner. It also prepares learners for Sanskrit studies at School Certificate level.

After successful completion of the course, learners will be able to comprehend, appreciate and translate adapted passages from prescribed texts, transliterate Sanskrit passages and apply the basic rules of Sanskrit grammar correctly.

### **Entry Requirement:**

- Pass at CPE/PSAC Examinations
- Working knowledge of English/Hindi
- Or
- Alternative qualifications acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute

(Optional Provision: Auditeur Libre)

### **Course Duration**

The course will be offered on a part-time basis for a duration of 2½ years (maximum 3½ years).

Blended Mode (face to face and online)

English/ Hindi/ Sanskrit
