CERTIFICATE COURSE IN BEHAVIOURAL AND PROFESSIONAL ETHICS (Part Time) (INTAKE 2026)

Applications are invited from prospective candidates for enrolment on the Certificate Course in Behavioural and Professional Ethics (Part-Time) on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka, as from July 2026.

This course is designed from wider ethical perspectives of both Indian and Western traditions to provide the students/participants a detailed account of ethics and its role in various professional domains particularly in policy-making by officials, law-makers and the government agencies. It aims at highlighting the nature and broad scope of ethics in connection to its role in making individuals and professionals morally sound and the society honest, transparent, and corruption-free. The module takes a multidisciplinary ethical approach, drawing on behavioral ethics, politics, public management, and law for examining and analyzing existing problems in public affairs and is of contemporary relevance. The module will focus on the components of professional behaviour in the public domain and on the practical obligation and responsibility of policy makers and public officials. The course will assist students/participants in ethically and realistically analyzing professional aspects of policy making and behavioral management from a range of moral, cultural, psychological, religious, political, and economic viewpoints. Topics will include: The Nature of a Profession, Professional Codes of Ethics, Human Behaviour, Confidentiality, The Problem of Corruption, Transparency, and Individual and Institutional Responsibilities.

The primary aim of this course is to develop in participants/students the skill of critical thinking on value judgments, decision-making, and policy practices in various professional settings.

Minimum: 1½ years

3. Mode of Delivery

Lectures/Presentations/Discussions

4. Entry Requirements

- (a) Minimum of three (3) credits with at least a “Pass” grade in the English Language at one sitting at the School Certificate or General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level; and
- (b) Passes in at least two (2) subjects at Principal Level at the Higher School Certificate (HSC) or General Certificate of Education Advanced Level.

OR

An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

- (i) Provision for Mature Candidates is available.
- (ii) Provision is made for “Auditeur Libre”.
