INTRODUCTION TO EPIC STUDIES

(INTAKE 2026)

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for enrolment in Introduction to Epic Studies course on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

This course offers an introduction to the major Indian epics, particularly the *Rāmāyaṇa* and the *Mahābhārata* and their enduring cultural, ethical and philosophical significance. Participants will explore key themes such as dharma, leadership, devotion, duty, morality and social values reflected in the epics. The programme also examines the influence of these texts on literature, performing arts, religion and contemporary society. Through selected readings and discussions, learners will gain insight into the relevance of epic traditions in modern life. The course is suitable for students, educators and the general public interested in Indian civilization and culture.

The course aims to:

Introduce learners to the literary, philosophical and cultural dimensions of the *Rāmāyaṇa* and *Mahābhārata*, with emphasis on themes, characters and values that remain relevant today.

The Course will be offered on a part-time basis for a duration of three and a half months.
