Introduction To Jyotiṣa (Vedic Astrology)

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for enrolment in **Introduction To Jyotiṣa (Vedic Astrology)** short course on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

This course provides a foundational introduction to Jyotiṣa, the traditional Indian system of astrology. Participants will explore key concepts such as planets, zodiac signs, houses, lunar constellations and basic horoscope interpretation within the framework of Indian knowledge systems. The course also examines the historical, philosophical and cultural dimensions of Vedic astrology and its relevance in everyday life. Emphasis will be placed on understanding Jyotiṣa as a traditional discipline connected to astronomy, time calculation and spiritual insight. The course is suitable for beginners and anyone interested in Indian culture and traditional sciences.

The course aims to:

Introduce the fundamental concepts and spiritual purpose of Vedic astrology (*Jyotiṣa*), combining theory, Sanskrit terminology and practical chart-reading skills.
