Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for enrolment in **Introduction To Vāstu (Indian Architecture)** short course on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

This course introduces participants to the fundamental principles of Vāstu Śāstra, the traditional Indian science of architecture and spatial harmony. It explores concepts related to design, direction, energy balance, environment and the relationship between human beings and living spaces. Participants will gain insight into the philosophical and cultural foundations of Vāstu and its applications in homes, workplaces, temples and urban planning. The course combines theoretical understanding with practical examples of traditional architectural principles. It is suitable for individuals interested in architecture, interior design, cultural heritage and holistic living.

The course aims to:

Introduce learners to the foundational concepts, practical applications and spiritual purpose of Vāstu as a science of spatial balance and well-being
