## Short Course in Terracotta (Part Time)

### INTAKE 2026

Applications are invited from prospective candidates wishing to enroll on **the short course in Terracotta (Part Time)** on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka.

This course is designed to enable students to acquire skills, knowledge and competence in working with local and imported clay. It will also encourage creativity, self-expression and the therapeutic benefits of engaging in the artistic process. Learners will develop practical skills in hand-building, sculpting, and modelling techniques to create functional and decorative objects such as pots, tiles, sculptures, and ornaments. This short course will encourage social interactions and provide opportunities for participants to share their experiences and creations with each other.

The aim of the course is to:

- Develop learners' skills and confidence in working with terracotta clay.
- Demonstrate different-hand-built, sculpting and modelling techniques.
- Guide learners to create functional and decorative sculpture pieces.
- Introduce safe kiln practices and clay firing process.

#### 1. Duration of Course

4 weeks course; two-week days and Saturdays (Week days: 15hr to 17.30 & Saturdays 9.30-12.00)

#### 2. Medium of Teaching

English/French

#### 3. Mode of Delivery

Face to face in the studio.

#### 4. Entry Requirements:

Applicants should be 16 years or above.

Mature candidates may apply.
