In the context of the commemoration of the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi and of the 50th anniversary of the Mahatma Gandhi Institute, the Mahatma Gandhi Institute invites you to contribute an article leading to an E-publication on the following: *Contextualizing Mahatma Gandhi's Philosophy in the Contemporary Era*. The main objectives are to put Gandhian thought in modern perspectives, to examine some of the challenges to intercultural understanding, social justice and peace, and to contribute to a reflection on potential sources of empowerment and peaceful modes of achieving social harmony.

Themes may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Intercultural Perspectives
- Social Justice & Equity
- Education & Empowerment
- Contemporary Global Issues
- Peace & Non-violence

The E-publication proposes to bring together the reflections of academics, educationists, diplomats and the civil society from diverse cultural backgrounds and experiences.

Paper submission details:

An abstract of a maximum of 250 words reflecting blend of theoretical rigor and empirical evidence in Font 12 Times New Roman is recommended. The text should include the title, name of the contributor, institution, keywords and the email address. A brief bio-data should also be submitted together with the abstract.

Medium of writing: English or French

Last date of abstract submission is **25th August 2020**

Contributors will be notified of the review outcome by **03rd September 2020**.

The length of the full paper will be between 3500 to 5000 words with Harvard referencing system.

Deadline for paper submission is **20th September 2020**
