### IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO STUDENTS - EXAMINATIONS

- The following will be considered as breach of examination regulations:
  - Being in possession of unauthorised materials inside examination rooms (small pieces of paper on which notes/formulae have been jotted down for revision, scribbles/formulae on the cover or back of calculators/rulers and others) or information written on book(s), paper(s) of any kind, on stationery (i.e rubber, ruler, calculator, or on other materials).
  - Writing on surface(s) other than paper provided by invigilators **during** examinations.
  - Being in possession of mobile phones or any other communication/electronic device during examinations.
  - Using unauthorised calculators, i.e. those with sound and/or facilities for storing and retrieving texts, graphical calculators, personal organisers, dictionaries, thesauruses, language translators and computers, and other devices capable of communicating directly with other similar devices.
  - Communicating with any other person (**except Invigilators**) during examinations.
  - Leaving examination rooms during examinations **without seeking permission from the Invigilators.**
  - Copying or trying to copy from unauthorised materials introduced and/or the work of another student and assisting another student to copy.
  - Taking answer books or supplementary sheet(s) (used or unused) out of examination rooms.
  - Temporarily leaving the examination room during the official examination time in an attempt to cheat.

#### General Clause

*The above list is not exhaustive and any examination irregularity taking other form(s) will be reported for Disciplinary action.*

- In case any unauthorised material(s)/ mobile phones or any other communication/ electronic device is in your possession **inadvertently**, please handover same to the Invigilator(s), **immediately**.
- Non-compliance** to UoM Regulations may entail Disciplinary measures whereby penalties imposed may lead to **suspension or even expulsion** from the University depending on the gravity of the offence.
- Familiarise yourself and comply with University Examination Regulations with respect to your conduct during and after examinations.**
